The File of Life is a small form that slips into a red magnetic pouch to secure to your refrigerator. The form, which you complete in advance, includes information such as your name, date of birth, medical conditions, allergies and medications. Doctors and emergency contact names and phone numbers are also listed. Insurance information and advanced directives can be included. When first responders arrive, all of your vital information is at their fingertips and valuable minutes are saved.
